**Coney Island / Brooklyn Bridge

Join us for a limited participation field trip to Coney Island and the Brooklyn Bridge.

WPS has chartered a 24 passenger bus to bring club members for a mid- to late-afternoon photo shoot at Coney Island. Nathan's famous, the Boardwalk, the beach, and the amusement park will make for a very interesting afternoon of shooting. After spending about 1 – 1.5 hours at Coney Island, we will re-board our bus for the short trip to Front Street, on the Brooklyn waterfront where, as darkness falls, we will have wonderful opportunities to photograph the Brooklyn Bridge and the Manhattan Bridge (there is a wonderful point just around the corner from the famous Gleason's Gym where you can photograph the Empire State Building perfectly centered under the tower of the Manhattan Bridge). Just a few short blocks away, is the landmark Jane's Carousel where some interesting photo opportunities of the spinning carousel can be found. The Brooklyn Bridge park is a wonderful venue for people watching, and shooting, as are the old, abandoned warehouses nearby.

This trip is already over half sold out! Our itinerary is as follows:

Depart from Westchester Community College at 1:00 pm

Shoot at Coney Island from about 2:30 – 4:00 pm

Shoot at the Brooklyn Bridge from about 5:00 – 7:00 pm

Depart for WCC at about 7:00 pm.

The price, per person, will be \$30.

Reservations and payment is required no later than the September 11th meeting. There will be no cancellation, or refunds, in the event of rain.
